
Emerald Lake Regional Park Notice Covid19 and 2020 Season – Update

Due to Covid19, the Government of Saskatchewan has now released the “Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan” which is attached for your reference.

After reviewing the same, the Board provides the following update as to how the “Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan” will effect Emerald Lake Regional Park:

ELRP will open to long term seasonal campers, overnight stay and limited-term campers on June 1, 2020. We will not be issuing a refund for the seasonal campers for the month of May. (**When the Seasonal Agreements were sent out in March, 2020, we advised that the Park would not be opening to the public until May 15th and closing on September 15th. However, we offered the seasonals a season defined as May 1st to September 30th as our Park Manager would also be in the Park for that period of time. We offered these extra four weeks at no extra charge to the seasonal fees.*)

All public areas and buildings will continue to be **closed**, these include the following:

- Main store and beach concession
- All playgrounds
- Indoor and outdoor showers
- All bathrooms except for one (only one household at a time may use this particular washroom)
- Main beach areas
- Camp kitchen
- Sport’s area

The golf course will be opening on June 1st.

- You must book your tee time in advance. There will be no walk-on tee times.
- There is to be one person/household per cart.
- If you are feeling ill – you will not be permitted to golf.

All bookings in the month of May will remain cancelled and fully refunded effective immediately. If you are booked into the Park for June 1st or later and we are advised that we have to close due to Covid19, you will receive a full refund. Regular campsite cancellations (non-Covid19 related) will adhere to regular cancellation guidelines. The campsites will only be filled to 50 percent capacity. Therefore, you will be contacted if you have already booked and need to be moved and/or cancelled.

The AGM will continue to be postponed until further notice.

The Park Manager will not be in the Park until May 15th.

In accordance with the Saskatchewan Government, you **must** maintain social distancing when attending at your trailer/cabin until otherwise advised by our Saskatchewan Government and Provincial Health Authority.

Everyone in the Park must adhere to the following:

- Just as is required at your primary residence, only your household unit is allowed to occupy your trailer/cabin.
- You must keep a minimum distance of 2 meters from others when walking in the Park. If it is not possible to be within a minimum of 2 meters from someone, please do not attend this area of the Park.
- No social gatherings over 10. *If you are unable to maintain a minimum distance of 2 meters then you cannot have a social gathering.
- After May 15th, please contact the Park Manager by email or phone for issues in the Park. Do not unnecessarily approach staff in the Park.

The health and safety of Park Patrons and employees is our main priority. We will continue to keep Patrons, campers, cabin owners and community updated via emails, mail outs and our website.
